WHAT IS PRP ?

Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) is a concentration of platelets and growth factors created from your own blood or bone marrow.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Platelets release proteins that decrease inflammation and promote healing. The concentration of platelets in PRP allows your body to recognize the injury as a priority and heals it more quickly and thoroughly.

WHY CHOOSE PLATELET RICH PLASMA (PRP)?

- Fewer side effects and longer lasting than traditional steroid injection therapy
- Natural and organic, derived from your body
- Speeds up and promotes healing
- Minimal down time
- Minimally invasive

ARE THERE ANY RISKS OR SIDE EFFECTS?

By extracting healing cells from your body and placing at the site of your injury, risks and side effects are very low.

AM I A CANDIDATE FOR PRP?

We will do a thorough evaluation to determine if this treatment is right for you. If you are taking anti-inflammatory medications or blood thinners, you may have to discontinue them until after your treatment.

WILL MY INSURANCE COVER THIS?

Currently, most insurance companies still consider this to be experimental treatment. If your insurance does not cover the treatment we will discuss other options with you.



WHAT IS THE PROCESS?

We will draw a small amount of blood from your arm and then spin the blood in a special centrifuge that separates and concentrates the platelets and other beneficial growth factors from the blood. After spinning is complete we will then inject the platelets at the source of the injury. The entire process takes approximately 30 minutes.
